**Definition:** Child Deaths are defined as deaths from all causes for children ages 1-14. The annual average child death rate per 100,000 is calculated by summing the number of child deaths from all causes for each year across the five-year period and dividing by the total number of children ages 1-14, then multiplying by 100,000. The total number of children ages 1-14 is estimated by applying the 1990 Census proportions to the population estimates from the Connecticut Department of Public Health for that year. Rates are shown for towns with more than five average deaths per year, except for Priority School Districts, for which rates are shown regardless of the average number of deaths per year.
